Monday, August 4: Girls on the Run Lottery Registration Opens at 10am

After a fantastic spring season, we're excited to offer Girls on the Run again this school year! This year's programming comes with newly adopted curriculum "Hello, Bold Heart!" which empowers our young ladies to:

- Build Confidence
- Nurture Emotional Health
- Promote Physical Activity

Girls on the Run utilizes a lottery process to select participants, due to high demand for the program. Our practices begin on September 15, 2025, and will take place every Monday and Wednesday from 3:15 to 4:45 p.m.

New guidelines from Girls on the Run require participants to miss no more than four practices per season. If more than four practices are missed, the participant will be removed from the roster to make room for girls who were not selected during the lottery process.

Each season, girls train to run a 5k while building their social and emotional skills, forging new friendships, and improving their confidence during a very formative time. This season's Girls on the Run 5k will take place on **Sunday, November 9, 2025**.

Monday, August 25: First Day of School and TK/K Early Dismissal

The first day of school for students in transitional kindergarten through eighth grade is Monday, August 25. Students may be dropped off in the front of the school at 7:55am; there will not be supervision outside before this time. Students will wait outside with their classes until the first bell rings at 8:05am. The school day begins promptly at 8:15am. The school day ends at 3:15pm.
