Car Line Reminders

Drop Off

- In the morning, drop off begins at <u>7:55am</u>. Please do not drop your children off before this time as there is no supervision.
- If your child/children do not need assistance getting out of the car, please stay in the right lane of traffic and pull to the furthest orange/red cone labeled 1 5. Students should exit the vehicle on the curb-side. If you are dropping off middle school students, please still pull to the next available spot. They can walk to their waiting designated area. Do not stop and drop them off by where their classmates are waiting.
- If you need to assist your children in getting out of their car seats, you may use the left lane to pull up to the green cone area in front of the crosswalk. If you plan to wait with your child in line until 8:05am, please park in a parking spot and do not leave your car unattended by the green cones.

Pick Up

- School ends at 3:15pm. If you are the first car in the pickup line, please wait on the west side of the drive until a faculty or staff member on duty waves you forward.
- Please display a car sign with your student(s) last name(s) during afternoon pickup to
 expedite the car line. We did not make car signs this year, but I ask that you please have
 your child/children make a sign with your last name written in a large font.
- If you have business in the school at dismissal, please park in the upper parking lot and walk to the building.

- If you have children staying after school for any reason and you need to wait, please park in the upper parking lot and do not enter the car line.
- If your child/children have car seats or need assistance buckling, it is helpful if you pull forward to the green cone area before/after they get in the car.
