

Organization of Living Things

Cell

- The structural and functional unit of an organism.
- All living things are made up of cells

Tissue

- A composition of similar cells that perform a similar function
- ex. Your bicep muscle

Organ

- When more than one tissue are working together and performs a function
- ex. Your heart is an organ

Organ System

- More than one organ working together to perform a function
- ex. Your heart, arteries, veins, and blood form the circulatory system

Organism

- When many organ systems work together it can form an organism
- All of our body systems (muscular, digestive, skeletal) form a human organism
